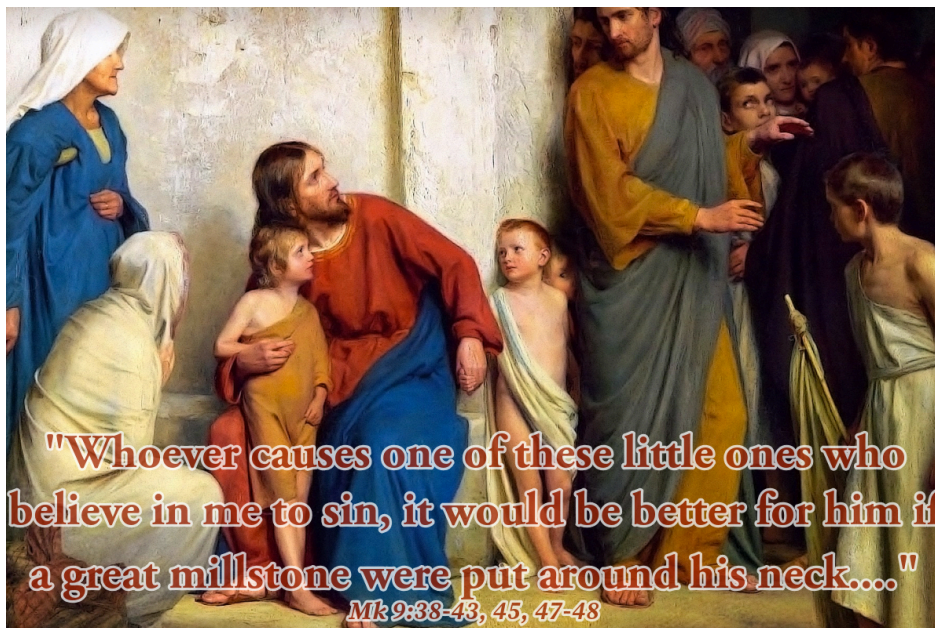

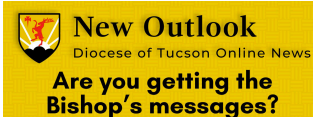

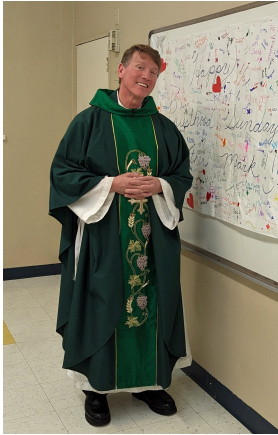

### Novena to St. Joseph on behalf of Fr. Mark

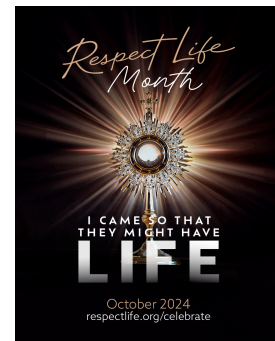

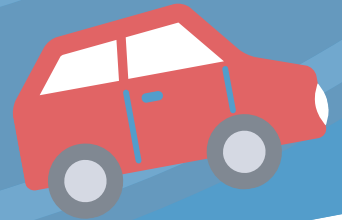
